Our security course at Bright Direction Training, gives you the skills and knowledge to work in the security industry. On completion of the course, you will obtain an SIA licence, which is a legal requirement if you are looking to work in security. Plus, you will get a guaranteed interview with SNSG security services.

You will complete the following units:

- Level 2 Award for Door Supervisors
- Level 3 Emergency First Aid at work



Level 3 Emergency First Aid at Work:

This qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider, how to assess an incident and recognising signs/symptoms of injury and illness. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED and assisting a casualty who is suffering from major injury and illness such as chest injuries, spinal injuries and anaphylaxis.

Level 2 Award Working as a Door Supervisor:

This part of the course is delivered over 6 days, and covers the four units that are required to get your SIA licence:

- · Working as a Door Supervisor
- Working in the Private Security Industry
- Conflict resolution
- Physical Intervention

PLUS

- Careers within the security industry
- Risk assessment
- Health and safety in the night time economy
- Improving knowledge in ACT awareness



To be eligible for government funding, you must be:



- Aged 19 +
- A resident of West Midlands
- Unemployed OR earning under £30,000 per year.
- Lived in the UK for 3 years or more
- Have a valid photo ID OR original birth certificate
- Have a good level of written and spoken English

It is important for the course, and to be eligible for an SIA licence, that you have a basic good level of maths, along with written and spoken English. Therefore during the induction day, you will take part in a short quiz so that we can ascertain your eligibility for the course.

HOW DO I GET THE GOVERNMENT FUNDING?

You don't need to do anything. We do it all for you! Just get in touch with us if you are interested in any of our courses, and we will have a chat with you to find out if you are eligible to attend our courses for FREE!

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO GET MY SIA LICENCE?

After completion of the course, it can take around 14 working days to get your results. You can then apply for your SIA licence. Your licence can take around 3-6 weeks to arrive - however, you will receive a reference number which most employers will accept until your physical card arrives.

HOW LONG DOES MY SIA LICENCE LAST?

Your licence lasts for 3 years. When your card expires you can do a short top up course to renew your badge.
